Accreditation Bodies maintaining recognition with the Department of Defense Environmental Laboratory Accreditation Program (DoD ELAP) must adhere to the DoD ELAP Conditions and Criteria for DoD ELAP Recognition of Accreditation Bodies. One condition within this requirement is as follows:

- Upon request, provide to the DoD Environmental Data Quality Workgroup (EDQW) copies of laboratory assessment documentation (i.e. assessor reports and checklists) and corrective action plans and associated objective evidence of resolution of deficiencies (where applicable), and any laboratory feedback on the assessors and/or assessment process.
